### SCORING

**Alex J. Murphy**--- Robocop I and II

**Api** is from The Quiet Earth. (One of the strangest PA films ever made)

**Bonner**--- is the main character from a series of PA books called The Outrider.

**Booga**--- Tank Girl by Jamie Hewlett, he was one of the Kangaroo mutants

**Brown Limper & Jonny 'Good Boy' Tyler** - Battlefield Earth by El Ron Hubbard

**Deunan Knute** --- from the manga and anime Appleseed

**Deyv of the Turtle Clan** Dark is the Sun by Phillip Jose Farmer (even weirder than GW!)

**DMK** - Tempest champ who beat cute older valley-girl sister in Night of the Comet also arrived at end of film to pick up cute younger valley-girl sister

**Dr. Cornelius** --- Planet of the Apes series of movies, comics, TV shows, and animated series

**Fors of the Puma Clan**---Lead Character in Daybreak 2225 AD also called The Star Man's Son by Andre Norton

**Ford Lincoln Mercury**--- The postman from The Postman

**Ford Prefect**---Hitchhiker's Guide to the Galaxy

**The Great Aku**---Main villain from Samurai Jack cartoon series

**Isherwood Williams** --- book, Earth Abides by George R.R. Stewart

**Jack `Cadillac' Tenrec**--- Xenozoic Tales, aka `Cadillacs and Dinosaurs by Mark Shultz

**Joe-Jim**--- Orphans in the Sky by Robert Heinlein, Inspiration for Metamorphosis Alpha. The two-headed leader of the mutants

**John Conner** --- Terminator 1, 2, 3 Future leader of the rebellion against the machines

**John Thomas Roarke**---Lead character in The Survivalist series of books

**Kamandi**--- comic book Kamandi: Last Boy on Earth- comic book character named after the military base he was born at, by Jack Kirby, who was also involved in Thundarr.

**Kaneda**--- Akira, the leader of the cycle gang

**Logan 5** --- Logan's Run movie and book ---He was a Sandman

**Max Rocatanski** - Madmax/Road Warrior/Beyond Thunderdome (but name only used in Mad Max)

**Milo Morai**-- Robert Adams' Undying `God' from Horseclans series

**Missus Hip** - the Mississippi River in Damnation Alley by Roger Zelazny

**Mr. Anderson**---Neo's "real name" from the Matrix series

**Mr. Frankenstein**---Deathrace 2000, constantly rebuilt driver and rebel

**Peersa for the State (Pierce)** --- A World Out of Time by Larry Niven

**Robert "Crazy Legs Bob" Neville** Charleton Heston's character in The Omega Man

**Russ and Ron** Those Annoying Post Bros. Comic by Matt Howarth

**Six-Fingered Jake**--- is from Cherry 2000

**Ukla** - Saturday morning cartoon---The Mok, from Thundarr the Barbarian

**Vic/Albert**--- from A Boy and His Dog
